Lactate Dehydrogenase (LDH) Specimen Transportation & Storage

Effective 04/25/2018

Due to specimen stability, the specimen transportation requirement for Lactate Dehydrogenase has changed from refrigerated to **room temperature (20 - 25°C).** LDH will now print on its own specimen number. Please collect one tube per specimen label.

Activity of LD-4 and LD-5 isoenzymes are lost if the samples are stored below ambient temperatures. For this reason, **St. Luke's Lab will no longer be able to process add-on requests for LDH.** If you wish to have an LDH performed, a new specimen must be collected.
