Testosterone Reference Range Change, Effective 10/25/10

Effective 10/25/10, St. Luke's Hospital laboratory will begin utilizing a new reagent for Testosterone analysis. The new reagent is aligned to Isotope Dilution/Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectroscopy. The accompanying reference range will change slightly.

New Testosterone Reference Ranges:

- Females: 0-73 ng/dL
- Males ages 20-49: 160-726 ng/dL
- Males \geq 50: 129-767 ng/dL

Old Testosterone Reference Ranges:

- Females: <20-81 ng/dL
- Males ages 20-49: 262-1593 ng/dL
- Males \geq 50: 181-758 ng/dL
