Test Update



Helicobacter pylori, Breath (BreathTek) FDA Approved for Pediatric Patients.

St. Luke's Laboratory is now able to accept specimens for *H. pylori* Breath testing on pediatric patients.

The POCONE analyzer that is used for measurement and the Pediatric Correction Calculator were recently FDA approved for use on patients 3-17 years of age. Specimens from patients 3-17 years old must be accompanied by the demographic information card for proper result calculation (see below).

Cards will be placed in all collection kits that are distributed from St. Luke's Laboratory. For kits that were distributed prior to October 15 2014, please request cards via the online supply ordering system.
