Criteria for Consideration in Awarding Whiteside Institute for Clinical Research Grants

Grants are available to any qualified health professional or researcher in the region.

A scientific research proposal should (be/have):

- 1. Focus on research in the areas of cancer, lung or heart disease.
- 2. Clinically relevant with sound scientific merit.
- 3. Involve collaboration: basic scientists proposing a translational project must have an identified clinical collaborator, clinical scientists also require a collaborator, either clinical or basic.
- 4. Publishable upon completion.
- 5. Potential to provide new information, technique or insight or innovation.
- 6. Potential for continued study and external funding.
- 7. Feasible, both technically and financially.
- 8. St. Luke's and/or University of Minnesota Medical School, Duluth involvement (weight will be given to this, but it is not a requirement).
